Overview of DAAD activities & particularly the University Partnership Programme

Abstract

The DAAD as an organisation of the institutions of higher education and student bodies in the Federal Republic of Germany promotes the international academic exchange. Furthermore it is an intermediary for the implementation of foreign cultural policy, national academic policy and for the educational cooperation with developing countries.

In the field of development co-operation the DAAD endorses in particular academic, scientific, economic and democratic progression.

Therefore it funds postgraduate degree programmes of relevance to developing countries, supports university partnerships, southern hemisphere partnerships, initiate academic and alumni networks in developing countries, gives scholarships and lectureships to support staff development within academic structures and has programmes for equipment, experts and executives from individual countries.

The university partnership programmes are of vitally importance and hold a special role within the development co-operation. Therefore the talk gives an overview about this topic wherein the referee will firstly explain what university partnerships are and secondly what they intend and how they are measured. Thereafter there will be given instructions how to start the subject-related co-operation in the higher education sector *step by step*, i.e. how to *initiate*, how to *establish* and finally how to *organise* the university partnership.

In addition the speaker will emphasise and point out the appraisal factors for a successful application to the DAAD. Aside from facts and numbers of funded partnerships and regional and subject-related distributions, examples of thriving co-operations with higher education institutes are given – not only to show the duration of partnerships but also the variety of subject-related co-operations.
